

Why is AF detection and management so important?





AF detection rates in SEL: 72%

CVDPrevent AF prevalence 1.46% SEL 2.41% England

QOF: patients with AF and CHA2DS2-VASc score: 93.85%

AF management with anticoagulation in SEL:

87.75% -1,460 patients to reach ambition of 95%

Please consider

- AF contributes to 1 in 5 strokes in the UK

 AF-related strokes are often more severe,

 with higher mortality and greater disability
- AF often goes undiagnosed:
 Estimates are that half a million people in the UK have undiagnosed AE- in SEL potentially 8k
